Over the past two weeks Year 6 has investigated what happens to an objects shadow depending on other factors.

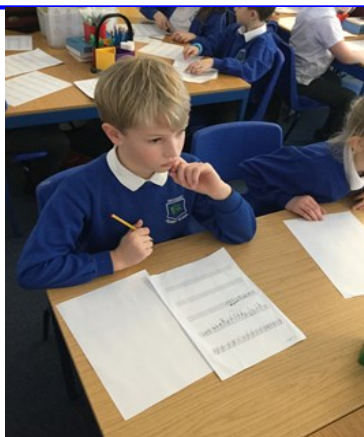


Year 6
