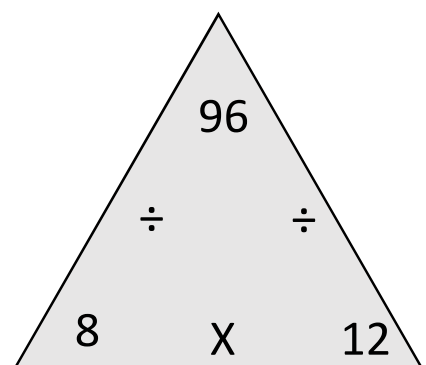
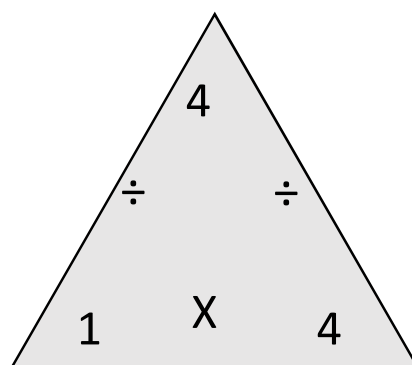
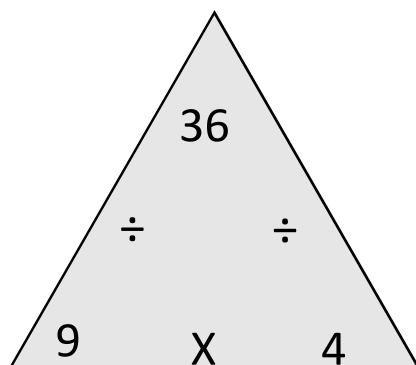
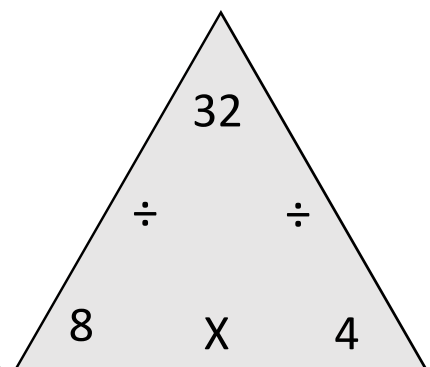
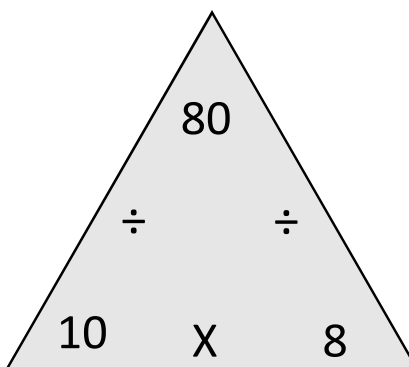
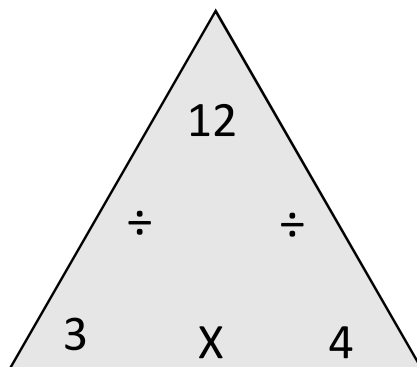
You may remember using multiplication triangles in class to make note of all the facts we can gather from one calculation.

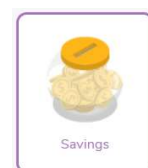


It is important that we learn how to manage our money. Have a think about these questions:

Activities:

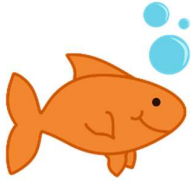
- Imagine you are allowed to choose one thing to buy. You can have anything you would like, and it doesn't matter how much it costs. Draw a picture and write a description of your item.
