

## **Sports Premium Spending 2022/23 Report.**

During the 2022/23 academic year Poverest Primary School has received £8,200 as a Sports Premium up to March 2023. We are however expecting more - around £20,200 in total.

Within Poverest Primary School all children take part in two hours of physical education per week.

During the Autumn term of 2022, 56% of children at Poverest primary school took part in extracurricular activities either before school, at lunchtime or after school.

Sports Premium money is used to improve the quality of PE and ensure all children are engaged in quality physical education. PE and Sports are valued and promoted across the school. Children, Parents and staff gain an improved confidence, knowledge and skill set in participation and teaching of physical education.

This overview includes money spent and forecasts spending during the 2022/23 academic year.
