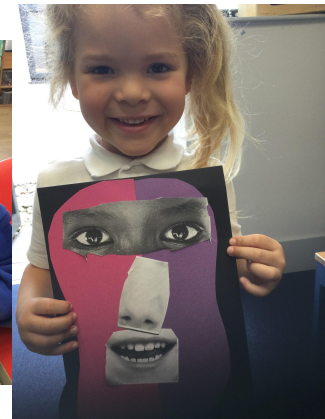
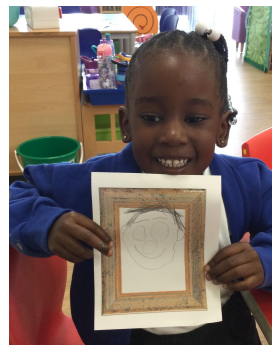
Understanding the World: We have been talking about our family history, creating family trees and the occupations of our family members. We have been learning about the seasons and talking about the changes that we notice.
