We kept our lights off all day and we played Phonics games rather than using the IW or chromebooks.

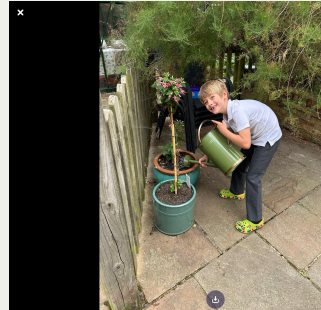




# Beech & Birch

We have been busy making some lovely bookmarks to be used for our reading books. We have also researched and discussed how to be kind to the planet Earth!

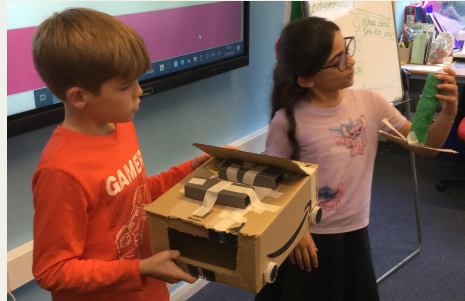
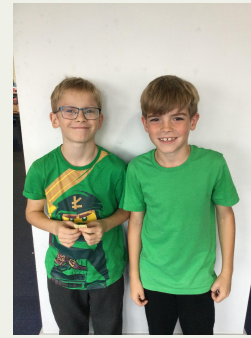
In Birch we have been eco warriors at home too...

We also made posters which linked with our literacy lesson about eco-issues like pollution.



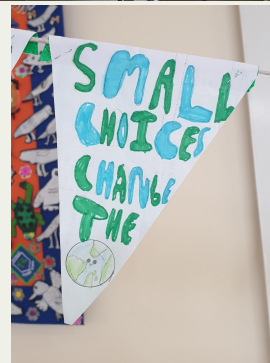


# Elder & Elm

Our classes spent this week researching Sustainability and during our research, came up with our own slogans to remind our families to look after our planet!

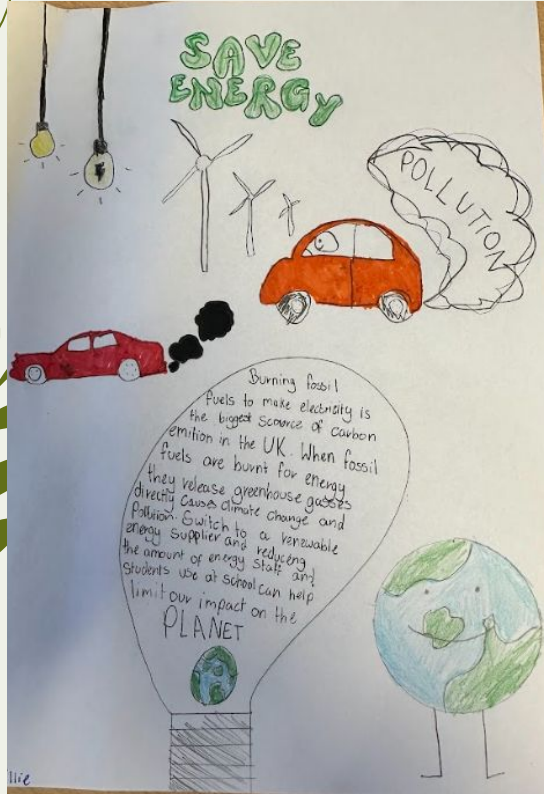
We created bunting to decorate the hall with our slogans on, using recycled electrical drawings!

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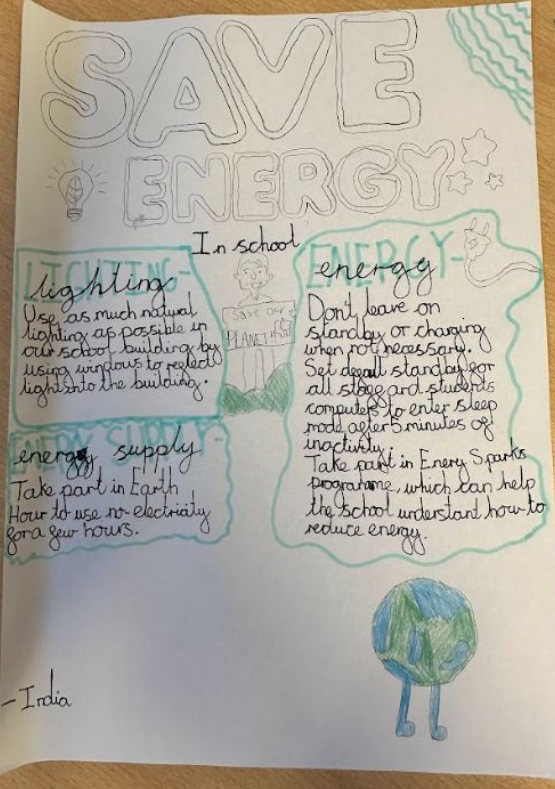
Dear Mr Haylock,
