SCHOOL JOURNEY NOVEMBER 2024

We are delighted to inform you that we have booked the residential visit for the next academic year when your child will be in year 6. A residential visit is a vital part of your child's education and helps to build their self-confidence and team work skills. It is a fantastic opportunity to bond with their peers and attempt many new challenges. Children in year 6 often remember a residential trip as their biggest highlight of their primary school years. We have made a booking at the Marchants Hill PGL Centre in Surrey, from Monday 11th until Friday 15th November 2024.

The cost of the trip will be £298. This includes accommodation, food and the 14 adventurous activities that the children will take part in. This can be paid in instalments as per the attached sheet. We would like to thank The Friends of Poverest for making a contribution towards the cost of the coach. We do recommend that you take out your own insurance to cover you if your child is unable to attend the trip through illness or fractured limbs as PGL do not refund for these reasons.

To secure a place please complete the attached sheet and pay the non-refundable deposit of £50 via ParentPay as soon as possible, but no later than Friday 5th January 2023. This will leave a further 5 monthly payments of £45 and a final payment of £23. You can of course pay more each month or the whole amount if you do not wish to pay by instalments.
