

DT- textiles

In this topic children learn to:

Sew a running stitch with regular-sized stitches and understand that both ends must be knotted.

Prepare and cut fabric to make a pouch from a template.

Use a running stitch to join the two pieces of fabric together.

Decorate their pouch using the materials provided.



History-

What is a Monarch?

We will learn to understand what a monarch is and the role they have to play in society. We will also learn about where monarchs have lived in history!

Geography-

What is it like to live by the coast?

In this unit the children learn about where the 'coast' is, what the human and physical features are. Carry out Geographical enquiry about the coast through a local visit.

RE- How and where do people talk to god.

Children learn what a prayer is and what different religions do when they pray to their gods. Children then learn about the different places that people can pray across different religions.

PSHE- Economic wellbeing and transition into KS2

Children learn how adults obtain money and the role of having a bank account. They also learn to talk about their skills and talents and the importance of these in the future for their careers.
