

## **Operation Encompass**

Operation Encompass is a unique police and education early intervention safeguarding partnership enabling support for children and their families who have experienced domestic abuse.

If a child has been present when a domestic violence incident has occurred and the police have been called, the police will notify the Operation Encompass School Lead.

Police will liaise with the Operation Encompass School Lead, before the start of the next day. Operation Encompass will then use the information shared, in confidence, to support the child with any difficulties experienced.

Domestic violence can include, but is not limited to, the following types of abuse between those who are or have been intimate partners or family members:

psychological, physical, sexual, financial, emotional, controlling behaviour, coercive behaviour, honour-based violence, Forced Marriage, female genital mutilation, and assault.
