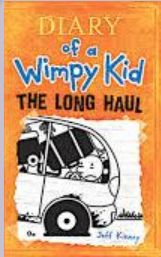
The children wrote the articles, edited each other's articles and made sure that the newspaper looked exactly as they wanted it to!

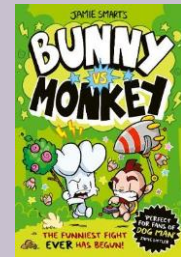
The book is really funny, especially the bit where Greg gets bitten by a pig.

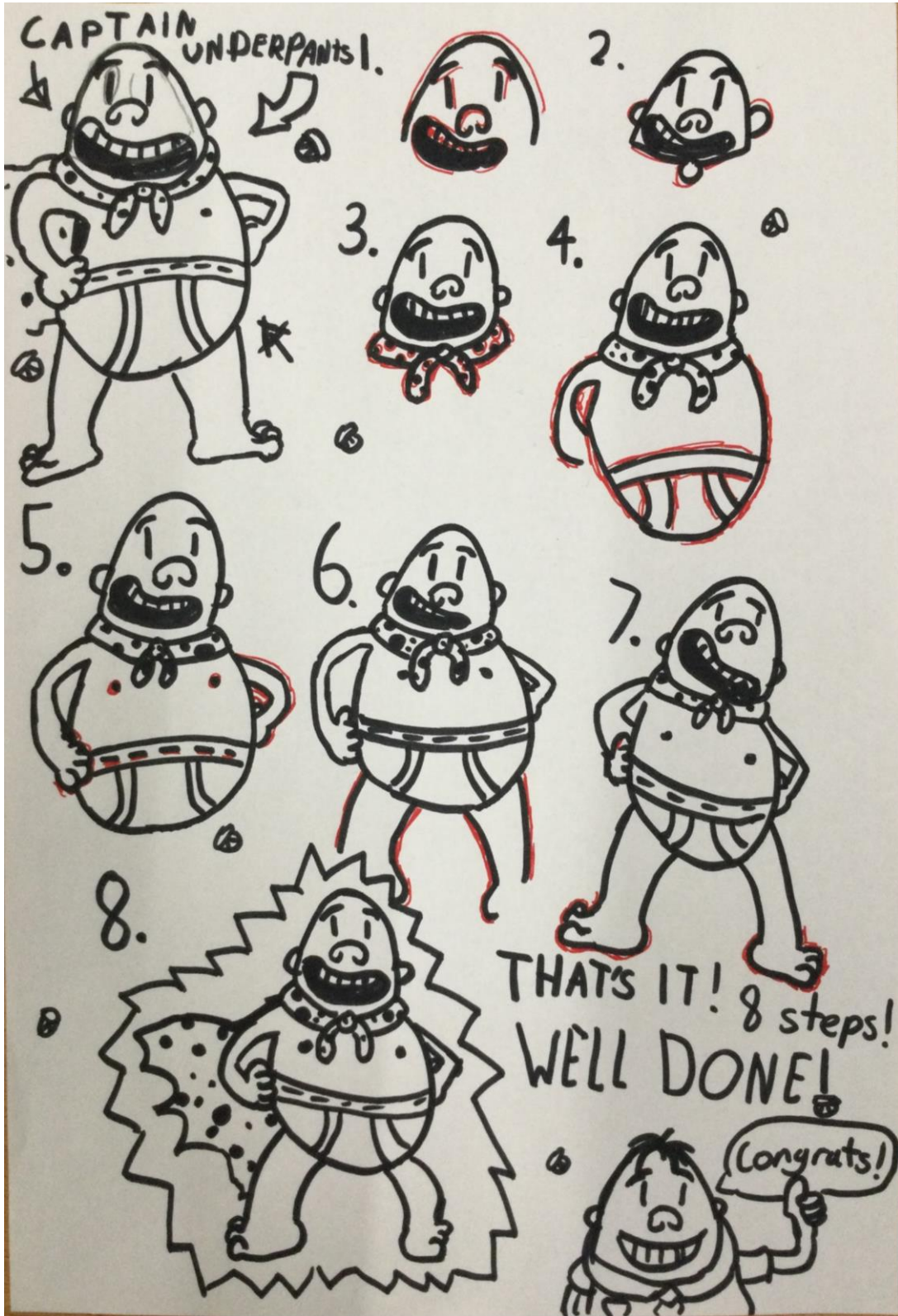

EASY 4 STEP PEANUT BUTTER COOKIES!

Step one: Heat oven to 180C/160C fan/gas 4 and line 2 large baking trays with baking parchment.

Step two: Measure the peanut butter and sugar into a bowl. Add one quarter tsp fine salt and mix well with a wooden spoon. Add the egg and mix again until the mixture forms a dough.

Step three: Break off cherry tomato sized chunks of dough and place, well-spaced apart, on the trays. Press the cookies down with the back of a fork to squash them a little. The cookies can now be frozen for two months. Cook from frozen, adding an extra minute or two to the cooking time.

Step 4: Bake for twelve minutes, until golden around the edges and paler in the center. Cool on

What they like to do: Go on walks and they like to eat a lot.

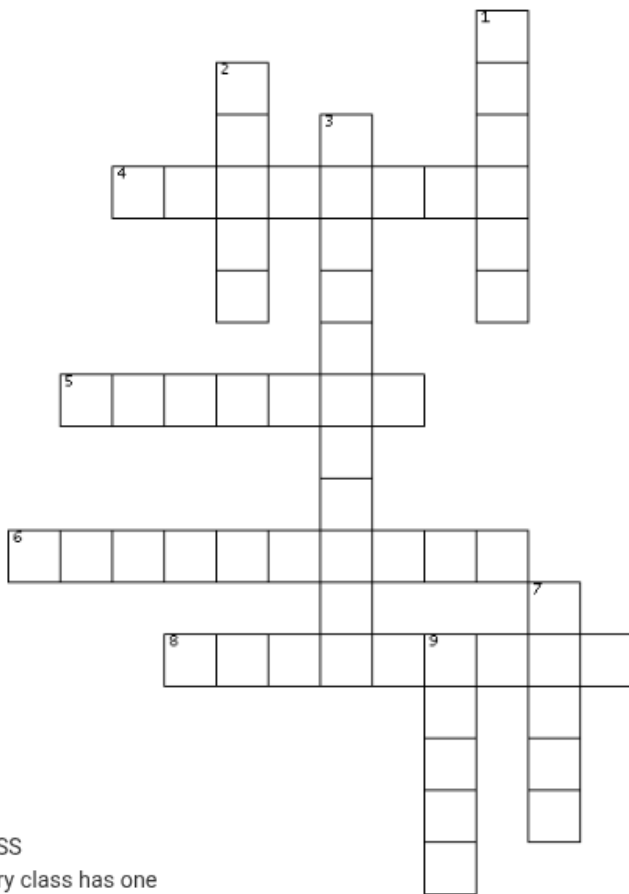


Teacher Spotlight: Mrs Dale
