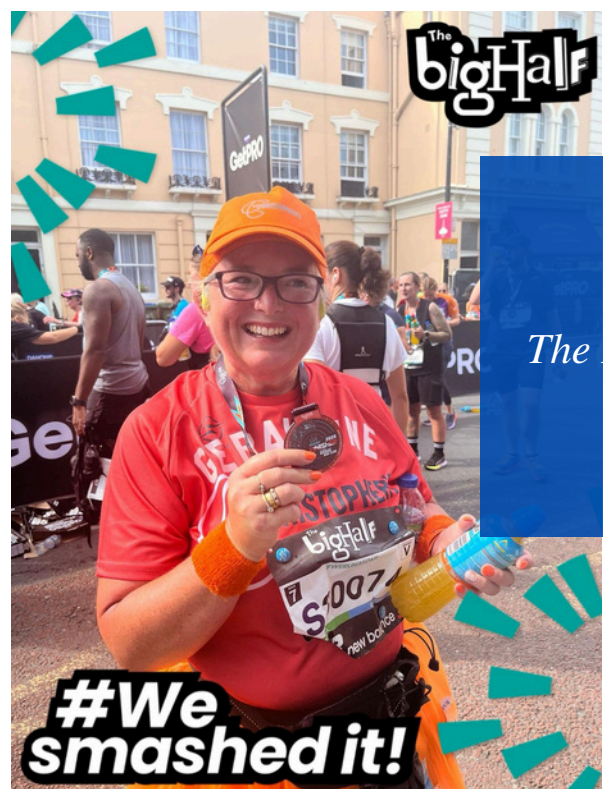


RUNNING FOR CHARITY

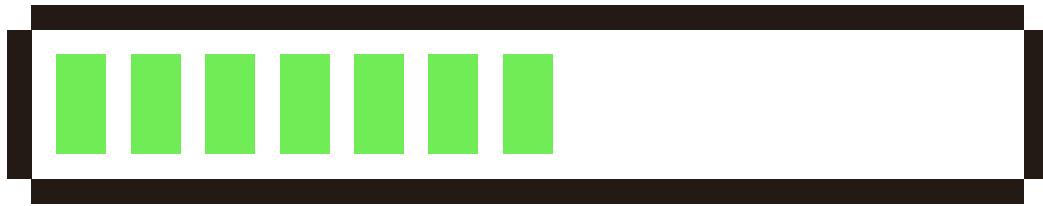
2. I WANNA TEST THE GAME

Not for the faint-hearted; it is incredibly difficult to excel at, yet it is also somewhat fun for some reason. Only the smartest people can actually find more than ten codes!

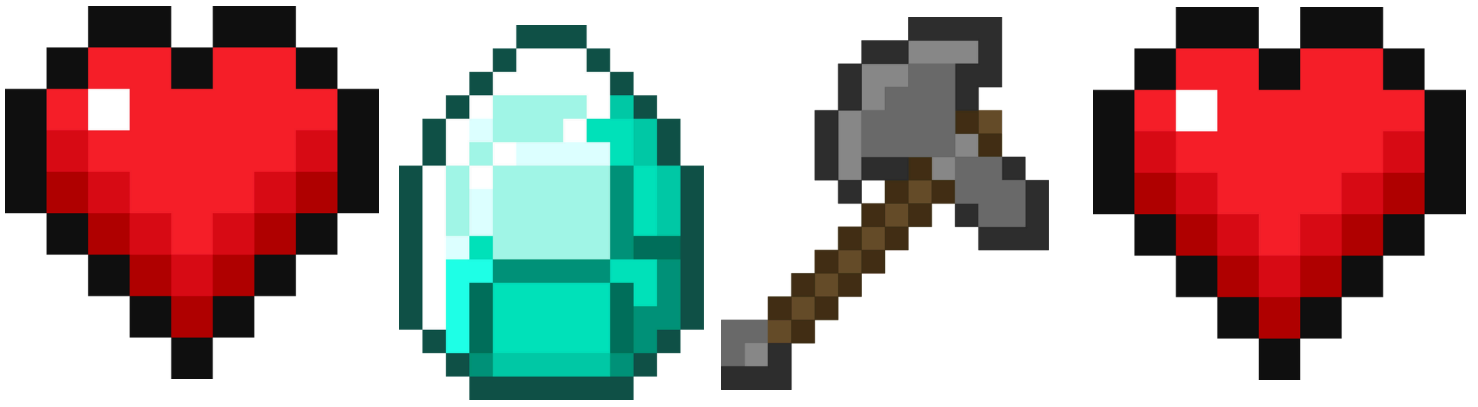
5. UNTITLED DOOR GAME(S)

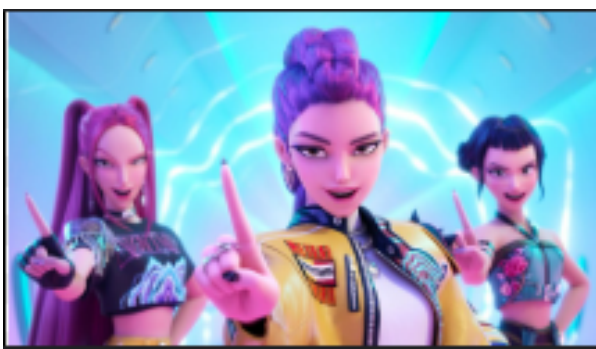
KPOP DEMON HUNTERS

WHAT ARE CAPYBARAS?

Capybaras are large, semi-aquatic rodents native to South America. Known for their gentle and social nature, they often live in groups near bodies of water like rivers and lakes. Capybaras have webbed feet, which aid in swimming, and they primarily feed on grasses and aquatic plants. As the largest rodents in the world, they can grow up to 4.3 feet in length and weigh up to 150 pounds. They are well-adapted to life in the water, with their eyes, ears, and nostrils positioned on top of their heads, allowing them to stay mostly submerged while keeping a lookout for predators.

Capybaras are fascinating creatures not only for their size but also for their unique social structures. They communicate through a variety of sounds, including purrs, whistles, and barks, which help maintain group cohesion and alert others to potential dangers.

FOOD FROM AROUND THE WORLD – MEXICO

One of the most iconic foods from Mexico is the taco. Tacos are made of vegetables, meat, seafood, or beans wrapped in a type of bread called a tortilla. Tacos date back to pre-Columbian Mexico, possibly originating from the Nahuatl word "tlahco," meaning "in the middle."

The next tasty food from Mexico is called 'Guacamole.' Guacamole is a type of dip (or spread) that tastes very good with tortilla chips. It is often preferred to be eaten on toast or traditional Mexican bread, bolillo. It is traditionally seasoned with lime juice, salt, and cilantro.

Next up, we have Pozole. Pozole is also a traditional Mexican dish. It is a soup, sometimes described as a stew, because it is made of hominy (nixtamalized corn), meat (pork or chicken), and can be flavoured in various ways, including red chilli, green chilli, and clear white broth.

Fourth on the list are enchiladas. Now, I know what you're thinking: 'Oh! I know what enchiladas are! They're a type of spring roll!' But no, enchiladas are a Mexican dish of rolled tortillas filled with ingredients like meat, cheese, beans, or vegetables, then covered in a savoury sauce and often baked with melted cheese on top.

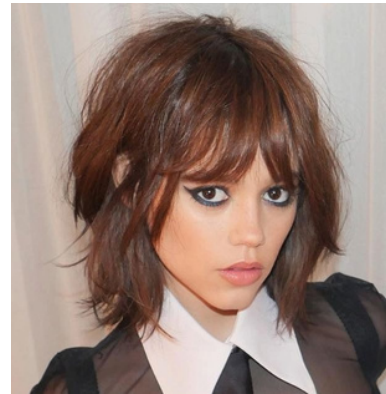

GIRLS' HAIRSTYLES



1. Pixie cut

A pixie cut is a short, bold, and timeless hairstyle that is shorter on the sides and back and slightly longer on the top, often with very short bangs. It is a stylish and low-maintenance cut known for its ability to create a confident look.



2. Butterfly cut

Cut is a long-layered hairstyle that creates a weightless, voluminous look by blending very short, face-framing layers with longer, feathery layers throughout the rest of the hair.



3. Short wolf cut

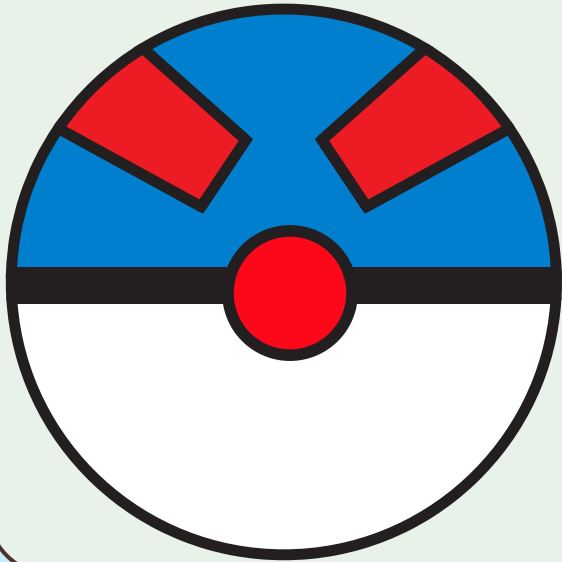
It's characterised by its voluminous layers, choppy texture, and a mix of short and long lengths. As a rule, the top and crown are cut shorter to create volume, while the layers around the sides and back are left longer. This gives the hairstyle a wild, untamed look, similar to a wolf's mane - hence the name.

4. Mermaid cut

A mermaid haircut is a long, layered cut designed to create soft, free-flowing, and voluminous hair that mimics the movement of water. It involves long, subtle layers, often achieved by overdirecting hair forward to frame the face and maintain length. This style emphasizes health, effortless movement, and works particularly well on long, naturally wavy hair, offering a low-maintenance option for carefree, "beachy" waves.

5. Layers

A layered haircut involves cutting hair at various lengths to create dimension, movement, and texture, offering a versatile look that can add volume to fine hair or reduce bulk in thick hair. This technique ranges from soft, blended layers that enhance a natural flow to shorter, choppy styles, such as the wolf cut, for a more dramatic or edgy appearance. Layers can frame the face, highlight features, and provide a flattering aesthetic for different hair types and textures, making it a customizable and enduring hairstyle choice.

Fun fact: It was the first Pokémon to appear in the Japanese Pokémon anime.

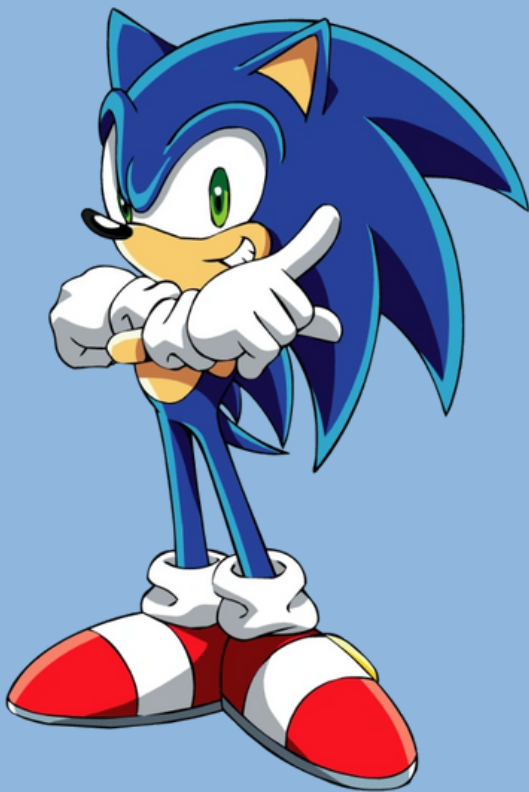

There is a funny character in "Henry Danger" named Schwoz, who enjoys having musical moments and is always silly.

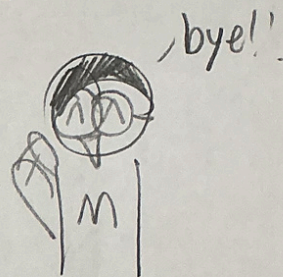
My favorite episode is "Henry Danger: The Musical." It is about Frankini making people sing and dance. I like this episode because I enjoy singing, though I don't like dancing.
