THE ORCHARD

Within our school, we provide a dedicated provision for children who are on the Autistic Spectrum.

Our provision is named The Orchard and has specialist teaching and support staff. The Orchard includes a sensory room and areas for external professionals - including Speech and Language Therapists, to support our children's needs.

Inclusion is embedded and highly valued in the school, allowing for all children to share facilities, learning opportunities and social interactions.





OUR COMMUNITY

Poverest is a proud member of the Aspiration for All Co-operative Trust (AFACT), part of the Cooperative Schools' National Network.

This provides opportunities for school leaders and teachers to work together, sharing expertise for the benefit of all.

We have strong community links and enjoy working with parents, carers and guardians. We actively encourage parental involvement, including frequent school visits and opportunities to sample learning and celebrate success.

All parents become members of our Friends of Poverest (FOP) community, providing fun and engaging activities that raise funds for additional resources and equipment.

CLUBS & ENRICHMENT

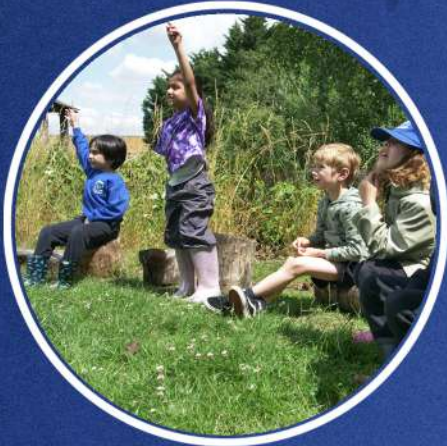


Sport and creative arts play an integral part in our school day and beyond at Poverest.
